# **Present Simple vs present Continuous**

present simple - přítomný čas prostý (opakující se) present continuous – přítomný čas průběhový (děje se nyní, nebo v blízké budoucnosti)

He usually wears jeans, but today she is wearing a skirt. Can I speak to

Mr Hill, please?—No, I'm sorry. He **is talking** to a customer at the moment.

I often **go** out with my friends in the afternoons.

What **do you do**?—I'm a bus driver.

What **are you doing** ? *I*'m writing an email to Mrs Berry.

Andy and I are going to a party tonight.

My grandma always **Drinks** black tea in the morning.

The Brookmans usually **go** to the mountains at the weekends, but this time they **are staying** at home.

We **are flying** to Rome next Monday.

Look at Mike! He **is jumping** into the river!

Jenny walks her dog every day.

Shhh! Little Arron is sleeping now.

Jeremy and Sarah visit their aunt in Chicago every summer.

#### Past simple, continuous

- 1. We were playing volleyball with Mary when you called me.
- 2. When the teacher **came** in, they **were studying** English.
- 3. The baby was sleeping when the telephone rang.
- 4. As I was walking in the streets of Holland, I met an old friend of mine.
- 5. I **lost** my car keys.
- 6. I was looking for my purse when I dropped my credit card.
- 7. My uncle **took** me to the airport yesterday.
- 8. She was dancing when she hurt her ankle.
- 9. It was raining heavily when I got up.
- 10 I saw the thief while he was getting into my neighbor's house.

### Present perfect or past simple

- 4. "When did he finish work?" "At 4 pm."

- 8. "Oh no! I have lost my keys! How will I get home?"
